REFEREES CORNER.



RULE: Mark for rollball after a touch. The position on the field of play where the player in Possession as at the time the touch was made. The most common misconception surrounding this is – players thinking the mark is where the defending player is standing at the time of the touch. **THE MARK IS WHERE THE ATTACKING PLAYER IS AT THE TIME OF THE TOUCH.**

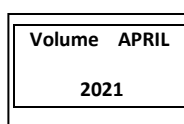
Online nomination forms are now open for all players wishing to trial for our Senior Representative teams.

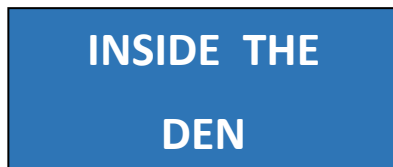
